## NB After-School Program Sign-up 2019-2020 Grade Level 3-6

We are pleased to inform everyone that despite the reorganization of the North Brookfield Youth Center, we will still be able to provide an abridged version of the after-school program! We have had to make some adjustments to the schedule and hours, but will be continuing with minimal changes to other aspects of the program. This means that we will maintain an emphasis on movement-oriented and hands-on activities, and will keep looking at every child as an individual in order to maximize growth and learning and help every participant get the most out of after-school.

The program will begin each day at 2:30 with a snack and social time to allow for students to decompress and transition from the school day. We will then move into Zones of Regulation, which helps target social emotional skill mastery. After that we will adhere to the attached schedule, which will alternate weekly between two programs, after which we will move into a 20 minute homework and reading block, time permitting. Pickup is promptly at 5:00 pm in Room 12A, which may be accessed via the double doors that lead to the Bell Area. We understand that things come up and are very supportive of all our families, but please be aware that a lot of our activities are project based and/ or team oriented, so repeated early dismissals will make it more difficult for your child to gain the same level of enrichment and to stay engaged with the activities. If you must pick up your child early, you may have to enter through the main doors as the side doors are not unlocked before then and certain activities are held in the gym or auditorium, but there will always be a sign on our outside door saying where we are, so you won't have to look hard to find us!

Programming begins the week of Tuesday, October 1, 2019. You will only be contacted if your child was not accepted/wait listed for the program. If you do not hear from us, please have your child report to Room 12A on the days he/she is signed up for. Please note, it is not required that your child attends after school every day, but it is strongly encouraged. Studies have shown that regular attendance at after school has a direct correlation to positive outcomes. The After-School Alliance reports that, "High quality afterschool programs can lead to improved attendance, behavior and coursework. Students participating in a high quality afterschool program went to school more, behaved better, received better grades and did better on tests compared to non-participating students. (Durlak, Weissberg, & Pachan, 2010)."

The program is limited to approximately 20 students per grade and is free of charge. If you would like to sign your child up, please fill out the attached sheet including which days we should expect them to attend, and **return to the office by Friday, September 20, 2019.**
